6 or local public safety employees from paying out-of-state or out-of-county tuition at
7 a public institution of higher education in the State; and generally relating to
8 nonresident tuition exemptions for spouses and financially dependent children of

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Education

15-106.12.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, “STATE OR LOCAL PUBLIC SAFETY EMPLOYEE” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 18-601 OF THIS ARTICLE.

(B) NOTWITHSTANDING THE STATE OR COUNTY IN WHICH THE SPOUSE OR THE CHILD RESIDES, A SPOUSE OR A FINANCIALLY DEPENDENT CHILD OF A STATE OR LOCAL PUBLIC SAFETY EMPLOYEE WHO DIES AS A RESULT OF OR IN THE COURSE OF PERFORMANCE OF DUTIES IS EXEMPT FROM PAYING OUT-OF-STATE OR OUT-OF-COUNTY TUITION AT A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE.

(C) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.

18-601.

(a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

(5) “State or local public safety employee” means a person who is employed in the State as:

(i) A career or volunteer member of a:

1. Fire department;

2. Ambulance company or squad; or

3. Rescue company or squad;

(ii) A law enforcement officer;

(iii) A correctional officer; or

(iv) A member of the Maryland National Guard who was a resident of this State at the time of death.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2026.
