A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Schools – Airway Clearing Device Availability and Use – Policy**
3 **(Bowen Levy Airway Clearing Device Act)**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring each county board of education to establish a policy to obtain
5 at least one airway clearing device per school and to authorize school nurses and
6 other school personnel to use an airway clearing device in certain emergency
7 situations; requiring the State Department of Education to develop and disseminate
8 a form for public schools to report each incident requiring the use of an airway
9 clearing device; and generally relating to the availability and use of airway clearing
10 devices in public schools.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Education**

19 **7-426.8.**

20 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, “AIRWAY CLEARING DEVICE” MEANS A PORTABLE**
21 **MEDICAL DEVICE THAT USES MANUALLY CREATED SUCTION TO REMOVE A**
22 **BLOCKAGE FROM THE AIRWAY DURING A CHOKING EMERGENCY.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 (B) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL ESTABLISH A POLICY FOR PUBLIC
2 SCHOOLS WITHIN ITS JURISDICTION TO:

3 (1) OBTAIN AT LEAST ONE AIRWAY CLEARING DEVICE PER SCHOOL;
4 AND

5 (2) AUTHORIZE THE SCHOOL NURSE OR OTHER SCHOOL PERSONNEL
6 TO USE AN AIRWAY CLEARING DEVICE ON AN INDIVIDUAL EXPERIENCING A CHOKING
7 EMERGENCY.

8 (C) THE POLICY ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION
9 SHALL INCLUDE REQUIREMENTS FOR:

10 (1) STORAGE OF AN AIRWAY CLEARING DEVICE IN THE AREAS WHERE
11 STUDENTS OR SCHOOL PERSONNEL PRIMARILY EAT; AND

12 (2) TRAINING FOR THE SCHOOL NURSE AND OTHER SCHOOL
13 PERSONNEL ON:

14 (I) HOW TO RECOGNIZE THE SYMPTOMS OF AN INDIVIDUAL
15 EXPERIENCING A CHOKING EMERGENCY; AND

16 (II) PROCEDURES FOR THE USE OF AN AIRWAY CLEARING
17 DEVICE ON AN INDIVIDUAL EXPERIENCING A CHOKING EMERGENCY.

18 (D) EXCEPT FOR ANY WILLFUL OR GROSSLY NEGLIGENT ACT, A SCHOOL
19 NURSE OR OTHER SCHOOL PERSONNEL WHO RESPONDS IN GOOD FAITH TO AN
20 INDIVIDUAL EXPERIENCING A CHOKING EMERGENCY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS
21 SECTION MAY NOT BE HELD PERSONALLY LIABLE FOR ANY ACT OR OMISSION IN THE
22 COURSE OF RESPONDING TO THE EMERGENCY.

23 (E) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP AND DISSEMINATE A
24 STANDARD FORM FOR PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO REPORT EACH INCIDENT REQUIRING
25 THE USE OF AN AIRWAY CLEARING DEVICE AT THE SCHOOL.

26 (2) EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT, ON
27 THE FORM THAT THE DEPARTMENT DEVELOPS, EACH INCIDENT AT THE SCHOOL OR
28 AT A RELATED SCHOOL EVENT THAT REQUIRED THE USE OF AN AIRWAY CLEARING
29 DEVICE.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
31 1, 2026.
