A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Correctional Officers' Retirement System – Redeposit of Accumulated**
3 **Contributions – Alterations**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing a member of the Correctional Officers' Retirement System
5 to receive certain service credit on the redeposit of contributions from the Employees'
6 Pension System or the Teachers' Pension System; and generally relating to service
7 credit in the Correctional Officers' Retirement System.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – State Personnel and Pensions**

16 25–304.

17 A member of the Correctional Officers' Retirement System who previously
18 terminated membership and withdrew accumulated contributions from either the
19 Correctional Officers' Retirement System, the Employees' Retirement System, **[or] THE**
20 **EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM**, the Teachers' Retirement System, **OR THE TEACHERS'**
21 **PENSION SYSTEM** may receive service credit for the period of employment during the
22 previous membership if the member redeposits in a single payment the withdrawn
23 accumulated contributions plus regular interest to the date of redeposit.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
