## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Safety – Immigration Enforcement Agreements – Prohibition**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the State, a unit of local government, a county sheriff, or  
4 any agency, officer, employee, or agent of the State or a unit of local government from  
5 entering into a certain immigration enforcement agreement; requiring the  
6 termination of an existing immigration enforcement agreement on or before a certain  
7 date; and generally relating to immigration enforcement.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Criminal Procedure**

16 **5-104.1.**

17 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, “IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT”  
18 MEANS A CONTRACT, AN AGREEMENT, AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL SERVICE  
19 AGREEMENT, OR A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE FEDERAL  
20 GOVERNMENT THAT AUTHORIZES THE STATE, A UNIT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT, A  
21 COUNTY SHERIFF, OR ANY AGENCY, OFFICER, EMPLOYEE, OR AGENT OF THE STATE  
22 OR A UNIT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT TO ENFORCE CIVIL IMMIGRATION LAW.

23 (2) “IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT” INCLUDES AN  
24 AGREEMENT MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH:

7 (C) THE STATE, A UNIT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT, A COUNTY SHERIFF, OR  
8 ANY AGENCY, OFFICER, EMPLOYEE, OR AGENT OF THE STATE OR A UNIT OF LOCAL  
9 GOVERNMENT WITH AN EXISTING IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT SHALL  
10 EXERCISE THE TERMINATION PROVISION CONTAINED IN THE IMMIGRATION  
11 ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT NOT LATER THAN JULY 1, 2026.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June  
13 1, 2026.
