A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Health Services Cost Review Commission – Term of Office of Members**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a member of the Health Services Cost Review Commission
4 to continue to serve only for a certain period of time after the expiration of the
5 member's term of office, rather than until a successor is appointed and qualifies;
6 repealing the authority of a member of the Commission who was appointed after a
7 term began to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies; and generally
8 relating to the Health Services Cost Review Commission.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Health – General**

17 19–203.

18 (a) (1) The Commission consists of [7] **SEVEN** members appointed by the
19 Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate.

20 (2) Of the [7] **SEVEN** members, [4] **FOUR** shall be individuals who do not
21 have any connection with the management or policy of any facility.

22 (b) Each member shall be interested in problems of health care.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



(c) (1) The term of a member is 4 years.

(2) The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Commission on July 1, 1982. The terms of those members end as follows:

4 (i) [2] Two in 1983;

5 (ii) [1] ONE in 1984;

6 (iii) [2] TWO in 1985; and

7 (iv) [2] Two in 1986.

11 (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the
12 rest of the term [and until a successor is appointed and qualifies].

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 October 1, 2026.
