A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Health Care Commission – Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Maryland Health Care Commission by
4 reducing the number of members who are individuals who do not have any
5 connection with the management or policy of a health care provider or payor and
6 including a representative of a hospital; altering the number of Commission
7 members who must be residents of different counties with a certain minimum
8 population; and generally relating to the membership of the Maryland Health Care
9 Commission.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **Article – Health – General**

23 19–101.

24 In this subtitle, “Commission” means the Maryland Health Care Commission.

2 (a) (1) The Commission shall consist of 15 members appointed by the Governor
3 with the advice and consent of the Senate.

4 (2) Of the 15 members:

5 (i) [Nine] **EIGHT** shall be individuals who do not have any
6 connection with the management or policy of a health care provider or payor; and

7 (ii) Of the remaining [six] **SEVEN** members:

8 1. Two shall be physicians;

9 2. Two shall be payors, as defined in § 19–132 of this subtitle;

10 3. **ONE SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF A HOSPITAL,**
11 **AS DEFINED IN § 19–301 OF THIS TITLE;**

12 4. One shall be a nursing home administrator in the State;
13 and

14 [4.] 5. One shall be a nonphysician health care practitioner.

15 (b) (1) The term of a member is 4 years.

16 (2) The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms provided
17 for members of the Commission on October 1, 1999.

18 (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is
19 appointed and qualifies.

20 (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the
21 rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

22 (5) The Governor may remove a member for neglect of duty, incompetence,
23 or misconduct.

24 (6) A member may not serve more than two consecutive terms.

25 (c) When appointing members to the Commission, the Governor shall:

26 (1) Assure that:

27 (i) At least [five] **FOUR** members are residents of different counties
28 with a population of 300,000 or more; and

3. One shall be a resident of Southern Maryland; and

(2) To the extent practicable, assure geographic balance and promote racial, ethnic, and gender diversity in the Commission's membership.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2026.
