A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Courts – Administrative Judges – Annual Stipend**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Chief Judge of the Appellate Court of Maryland and a
4 judge who serves as an administrative judge for a circuit court or the District Court
5 to receive an annual stipend in addition to the judge's annual salary; and generally
6 relating to the compensation of administrative judges.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

15 1–702.

16 (a) **(1)** Subject to the provisions of § 1–701 of this subtitle, a justice or judge
17 shall have the salary provided in the State budget.

18 **(2) THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE APPELLATE COURT OF MARYLAND**
19 **AND A JUDGE WHO SERVES AS AN ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE FOR A CIRCUIT COURT**
20 **OR THE DISTRICT COURT MAY RECEIVE AN ANNUAL STIPEND IN ADDITION TO THE**
21 **JUDGE'S ANNUAL SALARY.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

1 (b) The Chief Judge of the District Court, during the period he serves as Chief
2 Judge, shall have a salary equivalent to the annual salary then payable to an associate
3 judge of the Appellate Court of Maryland.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
5 1, 2026.
