A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Higher Education – Public Senior Higher Education Institutions – Direct**
3 **Admission Program**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing a direct admission program at participating public senior
5 higher education institutions for certain eligible high school students beginning in a
6 certain academic year; requiring the Maryland Higher Education Commission to
7 administer the direct admission program through a certain financial aid system and
8 the Common Application; requiring the State Department of Education and the
9 Commission jointly to establish a process for notifying the Commission of the high
10 school students who have met the college and career readiness standard each school
11 year; and generally relating to a direct admission program and public senior higher
12 education institutions.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – Education**

4 7-205.1.

5 (a) In this section, “CCR standard” means the college and career readiness
6 standards established under this section.

7 (c) (2) A student shall meet the CCR standard when the student meets a
8 standard in English language arts, mathematics, and, when practicable, science that
9 enables the student to be successful in entry level credit bearing courses or postsecondary
10 education training at a State community college.

11 10-101.

12 (a) In this division the following words have the meanings indicated.

13 (m) “Public senior higher education institution” means:

14 (1) The constituent institutions of the University System of Maryland and
15 the University of Maryland Center for Environmental Science;

16 (2) Morgan State University; and

17 (3) St. Mary’s College of Maryland.

19 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
20 INDICATED.

21 (2) “CCR STANDARD” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 7-205.1(A) OF
22 THIS ARTICLE.

23 (3) “HIGH SCHOOL” MEANS A PUBLIC SCHOOL IN THE STATE THAT
24 OFFERS A PROGRAM OF INSTRUCTION FOR AT LEAST GRADES 11 AND 12, INCLUDING
25 A VIRTUAL SCHOOL ESTABLISHED UNDER TITLE 7, SUBTITLE 14 OF THIS ARTICLE.

26 (B) (1) BEGINNING IN THE 2027-2028 ACADEMIC YEAR, THERE IS A
27 DIRECT ADMISSION PROGRAM AT PARTICIPATING PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER
28 EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS FOR ELIGIBLE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS WHO MEET THE
29 CCR STANDARD ESTABLISHED UNDER § 7-205.1 OF THIS ARTICLE.

4 (C) A HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT IS ELIGIBLE FOR DIRECT ADMISSION TO A
5 PARTICIPATING PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION UNDER THIS
6 SECTION IF THE STUDENT:

7 (1) HAS COMPLETED OR IS EXPECTED TO COMPLETE ALL OF THE
8 PREREQUISITE COURSES THAT ARE REQUIRED BY THE INSTITUTION TO WHICH THE
9 STUDENT APPLIES BY THE STUDENT'S ANTICIPATED MATRICULATION DATE;

10 (2) HAS MET THE CCR STANDARD ESTABLISHED BY THE
11 DEPARTMENT;

(3) APPLIES FOR ADMISSION TO AN INSTITUTION:

13 (I) BY THE REQUIRED APPLICATION DEADLINE ESTABLISHED
14 BY THE INSTITUTION; AND

15 (II) DURING GRADE 12 OF HIGH SCHOOL;

18 (5) MEETS THE ADDITIONAL CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE
19 INSTITUTION, IF ANY.

20 (D) (1) A PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION MAY CHOOSE
21 TO PARTICIPATE IN THE DIRECT ADMISSION PROGRAM UNDER THIS SECTION.

10 (II) REVOKE A STUDENT'S OFFER OF DIRECT ADMISSION AT THE
11 INSTITUTION IF THE STUDENT:

3. ENGAGES IN ACADEMIC MISCONDUCT; OR

21 (E) THE DEPARTMENT AND THE COMMISSION JOINTLY SHALL ESTABLISH
22 A PROCESS FOR NOTIFYING THE COMMISSION OF EACH HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT IN
23 THE STATE WHO HAS MET THE CCR STANDARD EACH SCHOOL YEAR.

24 (F) (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL ESTABLISH A PROCESS TO OFFER
25 CONDITIONAL DIRECT ADMISSION FROM EACH PARTICIPATING INSTITUTION TO
26 EACH ELIGIBLE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT BASED ON:

27 (I) THE CCR STANDARD DATA PROVIDED BY THE
28 DEPARTMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION; AND

6 (G) THE PROVISIONS IN THIS SECTION DO NOT GUARANTEE A HIGH SCHOOL
7 STUDENT ELIGIBLE FOR DIRECT ADMISSION PLACEMENT IN ANY SPECIFIC
8 PROGRAM OFFERED BY THE PARTICIPATING INSTITUTION OR TO ANY SPECIFIC
9 COLLEGE, SCHOOL, OR FUNCTIONAL EQUIVALENT WITHIN THE PARTICIPATING
10 INSTITUTION TO WHICH THE STUDENT APPLIES.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
12 1, 2026.
