2 **Anne Arundel County Public Schools – Election Official Career and Technical**
3 **Education Pilot Program**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Anne Arundel County Board of Education and the State
5 Board of Elections, in consultation with the State Department of Education, to
6 establish a pilot program in the county schools to prepare students for a career as an
7 election official; and generally relating to career and technical education in Anne
8 Arundel County Public Schools.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Education**

17 **21-211.**

18 **(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.**

19 **(B) THE COUNTY BOARD AND THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS, IN**
20 **CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT, SHALL DEVELOP A CAREER AND**
21 **TECHNICAL EDUCATION PILOT PROGRAM IN THE COUNTY SCHOOLS THAT PREPARES**
22 **STUDENTS FOR A CAREER AS AN ELECTION OFFICIAL.**

SENATE BILL 408

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
2 1, 2026. It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of June 30, 2031,
3 this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and
4 of no further force and effect.
