A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Carbon Removal Technology and Practices – Regulations and Use of Funding**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment to adopt regulations
4 governing the permitting of certain carbon removal technology and practices;
5 requiring each State agency to use available funding sources to fund carbon removal
6 projects that utilize certain carbon removal technology and practices; and generally
7 relating to carbon removal technology and practices.

14 WHEREAS, The current practice of applying solid waste regulations to the process
15 of carbon removal is unsuitable; now, therefore,

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Environment**

19 **2–1213.**

20 **(A) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2028, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT**
21 **REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE PERMITTING OF CARBON REMOVAL TECHNOLOGY**
22 **AND PRACTICES THAT ARE CERTIFIED BY AN INTERNATIONALLY RECOGNIZED**
23 **THIRD–PARTY CERTIFICATION BODY.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

1 **(B) EACH STATE AGENCY SHALL USE AVAILABLE FUNDING SOURCES TO**
2 **FUND CARBON REMOVAL PROJECTS THAT UTILIZE CARBON REMOVAL TECHNOLOGY**
3 **AND PRACTICES THAT ARE CERTIFIED BY AN INTERNATIONALLY RECOGNIZED**
4 **THIRD-PARTY CERTIFICATION BODY.**

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
6 1, 2026.
