A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Wicomico County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class B (Golf Course) License –**
3 **Hours of Sale**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the hours during which a holder of a Class B beer, wine, and
5 liquor (golf course) license in Wicomico County may sell alcoholic beverages; and
6 generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Wicomico County.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis**

20 32–102

21 This title applies only in Wicomico County.

22 32–1003.

23 (a) There is a Class B beer, wine, and liquor (golf course) license.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



(b) The Board of License Commissioners may issue the license for the use of a golf course or organization that:

(1) is open to the public;

(2) is operated for profit;

(3) owns real estate in the county; and

(4) has a golf course with a minimum of 18 holes.

(c) (1) The license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor for consumption on the land and in the buildings, including the clubhouse, used for golfing purposes.

(2) A patron need not be seated to be served.

(d) A holder of the license may sell beer, wine, and liquor:

(1) on Monday through Saturday, from [10 a.m.] **7 A.M.** to 2 a.m. the following day; and

(2) on Sunday, from [10 a.m.] **7 A.M.** to midnight.

(e) The annual license fee is \$2,200.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2026.
