A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Medical Assistance Program and Health Insurance – Required**
3 **Coverage – Mobile Crisis and Crisis Stabilization**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Medical Assistance Program and certain
5 insurers, nonprofit health service plans, health maintenance organizations, and
6 managed care organizations to provide coverage for mobile crisis and crisis
7 stabilization services; and generally relating to coverage for mobile crisis and crisis
8 stabilization and the Maryland Medical Assistance Program and health insurance
9 carriers.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health – General

15–102.3.

**(P) THE PROVISIONS OF § 15–864 OF THE INSURANCE ARTICLE APPLY TO
MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATIONS IN THE SAME MANNER AS THEY APPLY TO
CARRIERS.**

15–103.

(a) (1) The Secretary shall administer the Maryland Medical Assistance
Program.

(2) The Program:

(xxvii) Beginning on January 1, 2026, if providing coverage for
the delivery of anesthesia, shall provide coverage for the delivery of anesthesia in
accordance with § 15–862 of the Insurance Article; [and]

(xxviii) Beginning on January 1, 2026, shall provide calcium score
testing in accordance with § 15–863 of the Insurance Article; AND

**(XXIX) BEGINNING ON JANUARY 1, 2027, SHALL PROVIDE
COVERAGE FOR MOBILE CRISIS AND CRISIS STABILIZATION SERVICES IN
ACCORDANCE WITH § 15–864 OF THE INSURANCE ARTICLE.**

Article – Insurance

15–864.

**(A) IN THIS SECTION, “MOBILE CRISIS AND CRISIS STABILIZATION
SERVICES” MEANS IMMEDIATE, IN-PERSON MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS ASSESSMENT,
DE-ESCALATION, AND STABILIZATION.**

(B) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO:

**(1) INSURERS AND NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS THAT
PROVIDE HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS**

1 ON AN EXPENSE-INCURRED BASIS UNDER HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES OR
2 CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE; AND

3 (2) HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE
4 HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS UNDER
5 CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE.

6 (C) AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR
7 MOBILE CRISIS AND CRISIS STABILIZATION SERVICES.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all
9 policies, contracts, and health benefit plans issued, delivered, or renewed in the State on or
10 after January 1, 2027.

11 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 January 1, 2027.
