## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Local Government – Trap–Neuter–Return Policies for Community Cats –**  
3 **Requirements and Restrictions**  
4 **(Ash’s Law)**

5 FOR the purpose of establishing that a certain prohibition against abandoning an animal  
6 does not apply to a person who is providing care to a community cat under a certain  
7 trap–neuter–return policy; establishing that a local law that establishes a  
8 trap–neuter–return policy is subject to certain requirements and restrictions; and  
9 generally relating to trap–neuter–return policies for community cats.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **Article – Criminal Law**

(a) **THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A PERSON WHO IS PROVIDING CARE TO A COMMUNITY CAT UNDER A TRAP-NEUTER-RETURN POLICY IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 1-1321 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.**

(B) A person who owns, possesses, or has custody of a domestic animal may not drop or leave the animal on a road, in a public place, or on private property with the intent to abandon the animal.

[(b)] (C) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$100.

#### **Article – Local Government**

#### **1-1321.**

(A) (1) **IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.**

(2) (I) **“COMMUNITY CAT” MEANS A FREE-ROAMING CAT THAT MAY BE CARED FOR BY ONE OR MORE RESIDENTS OF THE IMMEDIATE AREA WITHIN WHICH THE CAT IS LOCATED.**

(II) **“COMMUNITY CAT” INCLUDES A FERAL CAT.**

(3) (I) **“COMMUNITY CAT CAREGIVER” MEANS A PERSON WHO PROVIDES CARE TO A COMMUNITY CAT, INCLUDING FOOD, SHELTER, OR MEDICAL CARE, UNDER A TRAP-NEUTER-RETURN POLICY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.**

(II) **“COMMUNITY CAT CAREGIVER” DOES NOT INCLUDE A PERSON WHO IS CONSIDERED THE OWNER, HARBORER, CONTROLLER, OR KEEPER OF A COMMUNITY CAT.**

(4) **“EARTIP” MEANS A PROCEDURE THAT:**

(I) **REMOVES THE DISTAL ONE-QUARTER OF THE LEFT EAR OF A COMMUNITY CAT;**

(II) **IS PERFORMED USING ANESTHESIA UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED VETERINARIAN; AND**

(III) **IS DESIGNED TO IDENTIFY A COMMUNITY CAT AS BEING STERILIZED AND VACCINATED FOR RABIES.**

1           **(5) (I) “TRAP-NEUTER-RETURN” MEANS TO HUMANELY TRAP,**  
2 **STERILIZE, VACCINATE FOR RABIES, EARTIP, AND RETURN A COMMUNITY CAT TO**  
3 **THE LOCATION WHERE THE CAT WAS ORIGINALLY TRAPPED.**

4           **(II) “TRAP-NEUTER-RETURN” INCLUDES PROVIDING CARE TO**  
5 **A COMMUNITY CAT.**

6           **(B) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ALL COUNTIES AND MUNICIPALITIES.**

7           **(C) A LOCAL LAW THAT ESTABLISHES A TRAP-NEUTER-RETURN POLICY:**

8           **(1) MAY NOT REQUIRE ANY REGISTRATION OR CERTIFICATION**  
9 **PROCESS FOR A COMMUNITY CAT CAREGIVER;**

10           **(2) SHALL AUTHORIZE THE TRAPPING OF A COMMUNITY CAT TO**  
11 **STERILIZE, VACCINATE FOR RABIES, AND EARTIP THE COMMUNITY CAT IN**  
12 **ACCORDANCE WITH FEDERAL OR STATE LAW;**

13           **(3) SHALL AUTHORIZE A COMMUNITY CAT CAREGIVER TO RECLAIM**  
14 **AN IMPOUNDED COMMUNITY CAT WITHOUT PROOF OF OWNERSHIP FOR THE**  
15 **PURPOSE OF:**

16           **(I) CARRYING OUT A TRAP-NEUTER-RETURN POLICY; OR**

17           **(II) RETURNING AN EARTIPPED CAT TO THE LOCATION WHERE**  
18 **THE CAT WAS ORIGINALLY TRAPPED;**

19           **(4) UNLESS VETERINARY CARE IS REQUIRED, SHALL REQUIRE THAT:**

20           **(I) AN EARTIPPED CAT THAT IS RECEIVED BY A LOCAL SHELTER**  
21 **BE RETURNED TO THE LOCATION WHERE THE CAT WAS ORIGINALLY TRAPPED; AND**

22           **(II) AN EARTIPPED CAT THAT IS TRAPPED BE RETURNED**  
23 **ON-SITE; AND**

24           **(5) SHALL ESTABLISH TRAP-NEUTER-RETURN AS THE PREFERRED**  
25 **DISPOSITION OF AN IMPOUNDED COMMUNITY CAT.**

26           **(D) THIS SECTION SUPERSEDES AND PREEMPTS ANY LAW, ORDINANCE,**  
27 **POLICY, OR REGULATION OF ANY LOCAL GOVERNMENT BODY, AND ANY POLICY OR**  
28 **RULE OF ANY PERSON OR CORPORATION, THAT PROHIBITS OR RESTRICTS THE**  
29 **PRACTICE OF TRAP-NEUTER-RETURN.**

1           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
2   October 1, 2026.
