

# SENATE BILL 794

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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Health Insurance – Special Enrollment Period for Pregnancy – Coverage**  
3 **Effective Date**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing an individual who enrolls for coverage or enrolls a  
5 dependent for coverage during a certain special enrollment period for pregnancy to  
6 choose a certain date option on which the coverage will become effective; requiring  
7 the carrier, if the individual fails to select the effective date, to select a certain date  
8 option; and generally relating to special enrollment periods for health insurance.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Insurance**

22 15–1316.

23 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

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EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



4 (3) "Health care practitioner" has the meaning stated in § 1-301 of the  
5 Health Occupations Article.

6 (4) "Qualifying coverage in an eligible employer-sponsored plan" has the  
7 meaning stated in 45 C.F.R. § 155.300.

8 (c) A carrier participating in the Individual Exchange shall provide:

(1) the special enrollment periods specified in 45 C.F.R. § 155.420 for individuals who purchase coverage through the Individual Exchange; and

14 (d) A carrier shall provide:

15 (1) the special enrollment periods specified in 45 C.F.R. § 147.104(b)(2) for  
16 individuals who purchase coverage outside the Individual Exchange; and

(2) a special enrollment period for an individual who purchases coverage outside the Individual Exchange if the individual or a dependent of the individual becomes pregnant, as confirmed by a health care practitioner.

20 (e) A special enrollment period described in subsection (c)(2) or (d)(2) of this  
21 section shall:

22 (1) be open for a period of 90 days; and

23 (2) begin on the date the health care practitioner confirms the pregnancy.

24 (f) (1) If an individual enrolls for coverage during one of the open enrollment  
25 periods described in subsection (b) of this section or during one of the special open  
26 enrollment periods described in subsections (c)(1) and (d)(1) of this section, coverage shall  
27 be effective in accordance with the requirements in 45 C.F.R. § 155.420.

5 (II) IF THE INDIVIDUAL FAILS TO SELECT THE DAY ON WHICH  
6 COVERAGE BECOMES EFFECTIVE, THE CARRIER SHALL SELECT THE DAY FROM  
7 THOSE LISTED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all  
9 health benefit plans issued, delivered, or renewed in the State on or after January 1, 2027.

10 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
11 January 1, 2027.
