1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County – Alcoholic Beverages – Barbershop and Beauty Salon**
3 **License**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing a holder of a barbershop and beauty salon license in Anne
5 Arundel County to provide a certain amount of liquor for on–premises consumption
6 in addition to beer and wine; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses
7 in Anne Arundel County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis**

2 This title applies only in Anne Arundel County.

3 11-1002.

4 (a) There is a barbershop and beauty salon beer [and], wine, **AND LIQUOR**
5 license.

6 (b) The Board may issue the license to a holder of:

7 (1) a barbershop permit issued under § 4-501 of the Business Occupations
8 and Professions Article; or

9 (2) a beauty salon permit issued under § 5-501 of the Business Occupations
10 and Professions Article.

11 (c) The license authorizes the license holder to provide not more than 12 ounces
12 of beer [or], 5 ounces of wine by the glass, **OR 1.7 OUNCES OF LIQUOR** for on-premises
13 consumption by a barbershop or beauty salon customer:

14 (1) when the customer is being provided:

15 (i) a barbering service under Title 4 of the Business Occupations
16 and Professions Article; or

17 (ii) a cosmetology service under Title 5 of the Business Occupations
18 and Professions Article; or

19 (2) while the customer is attending a fund-raising event at the barbershop
20 or beauty salon.

21 (d) A license holder may serve beer [and], wine, **AND LIQUOR** for on-premises
22 consumption during normal business hours but not later than 9 p.m.

23 (e) A license holder need not obtain a Sunday license under § 11-2004 of this title
24 to provide beer [and], wine, **AND LIQUOR** on Sunday.

25 (f) The annual license fee is \$100.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
27 1, 2026.
