A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City – Natural Resources – Sunday Deer Hunting and Archery**
3 **Hunting Safety Zones**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to allow a person to
5 hunt deer on each Sunday of the deer bow hunting season in Baltimore City; adding
6 Baltimore City to the list of jurisdictions in which the safety zone for archery hunters
7 extends a certain distance from certain structures; and generally relating to hunting
8 in Baltimore City.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Natural Resources**

22 10–410.

23 (a) (1) (i) The Department may allow a person to hunt on each Sunday of
24 the game bird and game mammal seasons in:

1. Allegany County;

2. Subject to subparagraph (iii) of this paragraph, Calvert County, from 30 minutes before sunrise until 10:30 a.m.;

3. Subject to subparagraph (iii) of this paragraph, Caroline County, from 30 minutes before sunrise until 10:30 a.m.;

4. Cecil County;

5. Subject to subparagraph (iii) of this paragraph, Charles County, from 30 minutes before sunrise until 10:30 a.m.;

6. Subject to subparagraph (iv) of this paragraph, Dorchester County, from 30 minutes before sunrise until 10:30 a.m.;

7. Garrett County;

8. Subject to subparagraph (iii) of this paragraph, Queen Anne's County, from 30 minutes before sunrise until 10:30 a.m.;

9. St. Mary's County;

10. Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, Somerset County, from 30 minutes before sunrise until 10:30 a.m.;

11. Washington County;

12. Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, Worcester County, from 30 minutes before sunrise until 10:30 a.m.; and

13. Subject to subparagraph (v) of this paragraph, Wicomico County, from 30 minutes before sunrise until 10:30 a.m.

(ii) The time restrictions under subparagraph (i) 10 and 12 of this paragraph do not apply:

1. On each Sunday of the deer firearms season; and

2. On the last three Sundays in October and the first two Sundays in November of the deer bow hunting season.

(iii) The time restrictions under subparagraph (i) 2, 3, 5, and 8 of this paragraph do not apply:

1. On each Sunday during the deer firearms season;

2. On one Sunday designated by the Department during the deer firearms season;

3. In Kent County, on each Sunday during the deer bow hunting season and the deer muzzle loader season;

4. In Montgomery County, on one Sunday designated by the Department during the deer bow hunting season; and

5. In Talbot County, on the last three Sundays in October and the first two Sundays in November during the bow hunting season.

(4) The Department may allow a person to hunt deer during the deer firearms season:

(i) On each Sunday in Harford County; and

(ii) On the first Sunday in Anne Arundel County.

(5) The Department may allow a person to hunt deer during the deer bow hunting season on:

(i) The last three Sundays in October and the first two Sundays in November in Harford County; and

(ii) The first Sunday in November in Anne Arundel County.

(6) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ALLOW A PERSON TO HUNT DEER ON EACH SUNDAY OF THE DEER BOW HUNTING SEASON IN BALTIMORE CITY.

(7) The Department may allow a person to hunt turkey on each Sunday of the spring turkey hunting season in:

(i) Carroll County;

(ii) Kent County; and

(iii) Talbot County, from 30 minutes before sunrise until 10:30 a.m.

[(7)] (8) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subtitle, the Department may allow a person with a deer management permit to shoot deer on any Sunday throughout the year in accordance with the terms of the permit.

[(8)] (9) The Department may allow a person using a State certified raptor to hunt game birds or mammals on each Sunday during the open season for the game birds or mammals.

[(9)] (10) The Department may allow an unarmed person participating in an organized fox chase to chase foxes on Sunday.

1 **[(10)] (11)** The Department may allow a person shooting pen-reared game
2 birds or tower-released flighted mallard ducks to hunt on Sunday at a regulated shooting
3 ground in accordance with § 10-906 of this title.

4 **[(11)] (12)** The Department may allow a person who is 16 years old or
5 younger to hunt on Sunday if participating in a junior hunt established by the Department
6 in accordance with this subtitle.

7 **[(12)] (13)** Except as provided in paragraphs **[(8)] (9)** through **[(10)] (11)** of
8 this subsection and subject to paragraph **[(7)] (8)** of this subsection, a person may not hunt
9 on Sunday in:

10 (i) [Baltimore City;

11 (ii)] Baltimore County;

12 **[(iii)] (II)** Howard County; or

13 **[(iv)] (III)** Prince George's County.

14 **[(13)] (14)** A person may not hunt migratory game birds on Sunday.

15 **[(14)] (15)** A person may not hunt on public land within the State park
16 system on Sunday.

17 **[(15)] (16)** (i) The Department may not allow a person to hunt on public
18 land designated for hunting by the Department on Sunday except in:

19 1. Allegany County;

20 2. Cecil County;

21 3. Garrett County;

22 4. St. Mary's County;

23 5. Washington County;

24 6. Dorchester County, for turkey during the spring turkey
25 hunting season;

26 7. Frederick County, for deer from the first Sunday in
27 October through the second Sunday in January of the following year, inclusive;

8. Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, Somerset County, on public land leased to a hunt club from 30 minutes before sunrise until 10:30 a.m.;

9. Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, Worcester County, from 30 minutes before sunrise until 10:30 a.m.; and

10. Subject to subparagraph (iii) of this paragraph, Wicomico County, from 30 minutes before sunrise until 10:30 a.m.

(ii) The time restrictions under subparagraph (i) 8 and 9 of this paragraph do not apply:

1. On each Sunday of the deer firearms season; and

2. On the last three Sundays in October and the first two Sundays in November of the deer bow hunting season.

(iii) The time restrictions under subparagraph (i) 10 of this paragraph do not apply:

1. On the first Sunday of the deer firearms season; and

2. On the last three Sundays in October and the first two Sundays in November of the deer bow hunting season.

(g) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, a person, other than the owner or occupant, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal may not shoot or discharge any firearm or other deadly weapon within 150 yards, known as the “safety zone”, of a dwelling house, residence, church, or other building or camp occupied by human beings, or shoot at any wild bird or mammal while it is within this area, without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.

(3) (i) For archery hunters in Allegany County, **BALTIMORE CITY**, Calvert County, Carroll County, Cecil County, Frederick County, Garrett County, Harford County, Montgomery County, St. Mary’s County, Washington County, Worcester County, or Wicomico County, the safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 50 yards from a dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.

(b) (3) (i) As part of the application for a regulated shooting ground permit, a person may apply to the Department for authorization to allow hunting on Sunday as provided under [§ 10–410(a)(10)] **§ 10–410(A)(11)** of this title.
