1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Producer Responsibility for Packaging and Paper Products – Definition of**
3 **Exempt Material – Alteration**

5 of law related to extended producer responsibility for packaging and paper products;
6 and generally relating to producer responsibility for packaging and paper products.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
