<p>Allegany College of Maryland (ACM), founded in 1961, is a public community college committed to delivering affordable, high-quality higher education, workforce training, and lifelong learning to Allegany County and the surrounding region. With more than 60 years of service, ACM offers personalized, challenging programs that prepare individuals for lives of fulfillment, leadership, and service. As a regional leader, the College remains responsive to community needs through credit education, short and long-term workforce development, and accessible recreational facilities. The proposed ADA improvements to Bazarnic Field support ACM's goals by ensuring inclusive, accessible recreational spaces for all community members, enhancing public engagement and reinforcing the College's commitment to responsive community service and lifelong learning opportunities.</p>		

**11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)**

Allegany College of MD strives to offer its athletic and recreation facilities for public use, including the on-campus baseball field. Recent capital investments to the field have improved the quality and playability and increased public interest in field use and event attendance. The increase in use and attendance have highlighted the need for ADA compliant accessibility from the parking lot to the spectator area and ADA compliant bleachers. The proposed project includes: line stripe and mark handicap parking, renovation of existing curb to ADA accessible standards, installation of concrete sidewalk from curb to spectator area, installation of concrete bleacher pad, and installation of ADA compliant bleachers. The current lack of ADA compliant access and bleachers, as well as general access, pose safety and usage issues. If funded, this project will provide safe and compliant accessibility and seating for attendees of all events at the ACM baseball field.

<p>The total amount requested through this bond initiative is \$61,031 to fully fund the ADA compliance improvements at Bazarnic Field, Allegany County's premier collegiate-quality baseball facility. These enhancements build on recent significant investments including a new natural-turf surface, state-of-the-art irrigation system, outfield fence, new dugouts, backstop, turf halo, and foul line area fencing which have elevated the field's playability and dramatically increased interest from both collegiate programs and the public. The proposed ADA-compliant access and seating will eliminate current safety and accessibility barriers, ensuring inclusive participation for spectators of all abilities at college games, intercollegiate tournaments, community events, and recreational uses.</p> <p>Allegany College of Maryland proudly keeps its facilities open to the community and will continue to manage scheduling, provide full maintenance and grounds care through its experienced Physical Plant staff, ensure safety via trained Security personnel, and offer abundant paved parking adjacent to the field. The campus's central Cumberland location conveniently near Interstate 68 and on a public transit route enhances accessibility and positions the improved facility as a draw for economic development, local tourism, and regional visitors. This project directly supports Allegany College's priorities for capital improvements that promote community well-being and public access to high-quality recreational resources. ACM remains fully committed to sustaining the field as a lasting community asset consistent with campus-wide standards.</p>
