<p>Carroll Classical Charter School is a tuition-free public charter school opening in Fall 2027 in Carroll County, Maryland. Our mission is to provide a rigorous, content-rich classical education grounded in the liberal arts, civic virtue, and strong character formation. Open to all students, the school is designed to expand high-quality public education options while strengthening academic outcomes and long-term workforce readiness. As we launch, we are securing a permanent facility to serve families countywide and ensure sustainable growth. State capital support will help establish a stable, community-based educational institution built to serve generations of Maryland students.</p>		

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Carroll Classical Charter School is seeking capital support to secure and renovate a permanent facility in Carroll County, Maryland, ahead of its Fall 2027 opening. While the school has secured startup and operational funding, public charter schools do not receive dedicated state capital funding for facilities. This project will fund acquisition, necessary renovations, safety upgrades, ADA compliance, and classroom buildout to create a safe, permanent learning environment. Establishing a stable facility ensures long-term sustainability, preserves public investment, and provides families with a high-quality, tuition-free educational option designed to serve students for generations.
