<p>The Galesville Heritage Society (GHS) was incorporated in 1991 with a clear mission: to discover, document, study, publish, and foster public interest in the heritage, history, and culture of Galesville, Maryland. The Galesville Heritage Society in 2001, with support from the State of Maryland, purchased an early 20th-century house on Main Street. In October 2002, coinciding with Galesville's 350th anniversary celebration, GHS proudly opened the Galesville Heritage Museum to the public. The Museum stands as the centerpiece of both the GHS and the village itself. Exhibits document the vibrant history of Galesville and its surrounding area and tells the story of Galesville's growth and the emergence of a close-knit community. The Museum welcomes over 400 visitors on Sundays from April through November, holding special events.</p>		

**11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)**

The Galesville Heritage Museum building roof is in urgent need of replacement. Continued deterioration places the historical structure itself and the artifacts it houses at existential risk. The Galesville Heritage Society is seeking assistance in pursuing a \$40,000 Legislative Bond Bill. The goal of this request is to secure funding to replace the aging Museum roof, a crucial step in preserving the building's integrity and Galesville's irreplaceable artifacts for future generations. The Galesville Heritage Museum is a publicly accessible, community-based museum dedicated to preserving and interpreting the maritime and cultural history of Galesville and the surrounding South County area. The Galesville Heritage Museum, located in Galesville, serves as an important steward of local history and a community educational resource.
