<p>The Greenway Avenue Stadium Capital Improvement Fund, Inc., a 501(c)(3) committee of community members committed to raising funds for capital improvements at Greenway Avenue Stadium Greenway Avenue Stadium Capital Improvement Fund, Inc. (GASCIF) hosts public fundraising activities, including annual events such as the "Walk a Mile for 'Ol Greenway one mile walk and mini-marathon, a cruise-in and car show, and other activities in the planning stages. GASCIF accepts direct contributions as well as personal donations and is currently facilitating the sales advertising panels that are attached to the new scoreboard. The GASCIF Group has strived to obtain funding for significant enhancements to the stadium in several phases, to markedly improve the facility for the community's benefit and use.</p>		

**11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)**

This project involves renovations of the restrooms on the Visitors Away Side of the Stadium. Currently, we have a single bathroom with one stall that may or may not be handicap accessible under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). The men's and women's bathrooms on the away side were each built in the past and are not ADA compliant. The user is required to step up into each of these restrooms, together with passing through two steel doors for access. The laboratory inside is not available to those with disabilities, and a person confined to a wheelchair could not function even if they could access the facilities. The away side of the stadium was renovated to permit 13 ADA spaces at the top of the bleachers. Nonetheless, these individuals do not have access to restrooms at the stadium. Our committee is requesting your support in applying for a \$400,000 bond bill to help with this restroom phase and provide the ADA Compliant facilities.
