10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)		
The Indian Cultural Association (ICA) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit dedicated to preserving Indian heritage, strengthening community bonds, and advancing cultural understanding across Howard County. For eight years, ICA has served over 100,000 residents. Honored with the 2025 Howard County Human Rights Award, the inaugural AAPI Public Service award from the Comptroller of MD, and the Governors #MDStrong Award, ICA is both a cultural anchor and a humanitarian force. Indian Americans are the largest immigrant minority in Howard County, with over 10% of residents (35,000+) tracing their origins to the Indian subcontinent. ICA's goal is to empower all Howard County residents by providing inclusive, in-person support by uplifting diverse communities, and breaking down barriers. All ICA programming is free and open to all.		

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

ICA is seeking LBI support to develop an accessible community space that will strengthen cultural engagement, expand youth and senior programs, and enhance our ability to serve residents with dignity. This project will establish a centralized hub for volunteer management, program coordination, and direct service delivery. The facility will include a professional office suite and a small gathering space to support staff and community visitors. By consolidating operations on this long-term leased property (20-year term), ICA will significantly boost operational efficiency. This permanent home ensures the sustainability of ICAs award-winning programs, providing a stable environment for the hundreds of volunteers who drive our mission.
