<p>Horizon Goodwill Industries is a people-focused not-for-profit workforce and human services organization headquartered in Hagerstown, MD and serving Washington, Allegany, and Garrett counties. We believe most individuals aspire to improve their social mobility through meaningful employment but often encounter systemic barriers to success that cannot be overcome without assistance. In response to these circumstances, we utilize a person-centered, holistic, and wrap-around services approach designed to help people get from where they are to where they want to be. Our model strives to be low or no barrier and recognizes that each individual has their own hopes, opportunities, and challenges requiring a uniquely tailored solution for each person.</p>		

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The project is a partnership between Horizon Goodwill Industries and Vehicles for Change (VFC), to utilize an existing vehicle repair facility located on the former grounds of the Washington County prison (used until 1984) to expand access to affordable, reliable transportation while creating workforce training and employment pathways for individuals facing barriers to work. Building on VFC's successful history, the expansion to Hagerstown will support vehicle reconditioning, job training, and program operations, enabling low-income households to obtain dependable vehicles essential for employment, education, and family stability. By combining Horizon Goodwill's workforce development expertise with Vehicles for Change's proven automotive training and car distribution model, the project strengthens regional economic mobility, supports employer workforce needs, and advances equitable access to opportunity in Western Maryland.
