

## Chapter 564

## (Senate Bill 313)

AN ACT concerning

~~Courts – Administrative Judges – Annual Stipend~~  
Judicial and Quasi-Judicial Employees – Compensation

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Chief Judge of the Appellate Court of Maryland and a judge who serves as an administrative judge for a circuit court or the District Court to receive an annual stipend in addition to the judge's annual salary; altering the compensation of the Chairman of the Workers' Compensation Commission to be at least equal to the salary of the Chief Judge of the District Court; and generally relating to the compensation of ~~administrative judges~~ certain judicial and quasi-judicial employees.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

1–702.

(a) **(1)** Subject to the provisions of § 1–701 of this subtitle, a justice or judge shall have the salary provided in the State budget.

**(2) THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE APPELLATE COURT OF MARYLAND AND A JUDGE WHO SERVES AS AN ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE FOR A CIRCUIT COURT OR THE DISTRICT COURT MAY RECEIVE AN ANNUAL STIPEND IN ADDITION TO THE JUDGE'S ANNUAL SALARY.**

(b) The Chief Judge of the District Court, during the period ~~he~~ THE INDIVIDUAL serves as Chief Judge, shall have a salary equivalent to the annual salary then payable to an associate judge of the Appellate Court of Maryland.

**Article – Labor and Employment**

9-101.

(a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.

(d) “Commission” means the State Workers’ Compensation Commission.

9-304.

(b) (1) Each member of the Commission is entitled to:

(i) the salary provided in the State budget; and

(ii) reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

(2) The annual salary of a member of the Commission:

(i) shall at least equal the salary provided in the State budget for a judge of the district court; and

(ii) for the Chairman, shall [be at least \$1,500 more than the salary of the other members] AT LEAST EQUAL THE SALARY OF THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE DISTRICT COURT.

(3) Except as provided in paragraphs (1) and (2) of this subsection, a member of the Commission may not receive a fee or perquisite for the discharge of any duty of office.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2026.
