Rules and Executive Nominations

**Annotated Code - Terminology - Clergy and Churches, Faith Institutions, and
Places of Worship**

This bill alters terminology throughout the Maryland Annotated Code so that (1) references to clergymen are replaced with terms that are religiously and gender neutral and (2) references to churches are replaced with terms that are religiously neutral, including “faith institutions” and “places of worship.” A “faith institution” is any Christian, Jewish, Islamic, Buddhist, or Hindu congregation, or any other religious society, congregation, or denomination. The bill also makes conforming changes.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill is technical in nature and has no effect on governmental operations or finances.

Current Law: Generally, the Maryland Annotated Code refers to clergymen in gendered language and religious institutions as churches.
