Reevaluation of the Baltimore Therapeutic Treatment Center (BTTC): The Governor’s fiscal 2027 budget plan includes the deferral of the 854-bed pretrial treatment-focused detention facility for adult men and women in Baltimore City. Construction of BTTC is intended to improve health and mental health services and bring the State into compliance with the 2016 Duvall settlement agreement. The decision to defer the start of construction to fiscal 2028 helps facilitate the use of the bond program for operating relief measures. The deferral also provides an opportunity for the State to reevaluate the size and scope of the project and the components needed to come into compliance with Duvall. The committees therefore request that the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services (DPSCS) in consultation with the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and the Department of General Services (DGS) submit a report by December 1, 2026, reevaluating the size and scope of the BTTC project.
