HB 1656 Delegate McComas

COMMERCIAL LAW – CONSUMER PRIVACY AND DATA
COLLECTION

Requiring certain businesses that collect a consumer's personal information to provide certain clear and conspicuous notices to the consumer at or before the point of collection; authorizing a consumer to submit a certain request for information to a certain business that collects the consumer's personal information; requiring a certain business to comply with a certain request for information in a certain manner and within a certain time; establishing the Consumer Privacy Fund; etc.

PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION –
NONSTUDENT MEMBER COMPENSATION AND STUDENT MEMBER
SCHOLARSHIP PG 505–20

Increasing the compensation of the chair of the Prince George's County Board of Education from \$19,000 to \$30,000, beginning on or after December 1, 2020; increasing the compensation of the other elected and appointed members of the Board from \$18,000 to \$25,000, beginning on or after December 1, 2020; and requiring that a student member who completes a full term on the Board be granted a \$5,000 scholarship to be applied toward the student's higher education costs.
