## SENATE BILLS INTRODUCED *February 20, 2021*

### **SB 957**     **Senator Young**

#### CRIMINAL LAW – THREAT AGAINST PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICIAL

Prohibiting a person from making or sending a threat to a public health official with the intent to intimidate, interfere with, or impede a public health official from performing the official's duties; and providing that a person who violates the Act is guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to imprisonment of up to 90 days and a fine of up to \$500, or both.

### **SB 958**     **Senators Zucker and Peters**

#### NONPUBLIC SPECIAL EDUCATION SCHOOLS – STATE CONTRIBUTION – INCREASE

Requiring the State contribution to the cost of educating children with disabilities in nonpublic programs to be increased for certain purposes by 4% in fiscal year 2023 over the amount approved by the State Department of Education in fiscal year 2022; and requiring the State contribution to be increased in fiscal year 2023 by not less than an additional 2% or the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for certain purposes.

This bill requires a mandated appropriation in the annual budget bill.
