HB 837 Delegate Clippinger

CANNABIS REFORM

Requiring the Natalie M. LaPrade Medical Cannabis Commission, in consultation with certain stakeholders, to conduct a certain baseline study of cannabis use in the State; altering certain provisions relating to penalties, charging procedures, expungement, shielding, and sentencing for certain offenses involving marijuana; legalizing the use and possession of a certain quantity of marijuana by a person who is at least 21 years old; establishing the Cannabis Public Health Advisory Council; etc.

HB 613 Delegate Griffith, et al

PUBLIC SCHOOLS – APPROPRIATIONS FOR SCHOOL SAFETY
EXPENDITURES – INCREASE

Increasing from \$10,000,000 to \$20,000,000 certain annual appropriations for certain school safety expenditures beginning in fiscal year 2024.

This bill requires a mandated appropriation in the annual budget bill.
