HB 1462 Delegate Cox

HEALTH – IVERMECTIN – STANDING ORDER (PROTOCOL DRUG ACT)

Authorizing licensed physicians and advanced practice registered nurses to prescribe ivermectin by issuing a standing order; and establishing procedures for pharmacists to follow when issuing ivermectin under a standing order.

BIOMETRIC AUTHENTICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR GOVERNMENTAL SERVICES – PROHIBITION

Prohibiting the requirement of biometric authentication by a federal or State governmental entity or federal or State agency in order for an individual to access a governmental account or governmental service.

HB 1464 Delegate Sample–Hughes**MARYLAND LOAN ASSISTANCE REPAYMENT PROGRAM FOR PHYSICIANS AND PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS – ALTERATIONS**

Clarifying that part–time physicians and physician assistants are eligible for participation in the Maryland Loan Assistance Repayment Program for Physicians and Physician Assistants; authorizing the Maryland Department of Health to establish prorated loan repayment assistance for part–time physicians and physician assistants; and establishing the Maryland Loan Assistance Repayment Program Advisory Council to assist the Department in the administration of the Program.

HB 1465 Delegate Jacobs, et al**KENT COUNTY – ARCHERY HUNTING – SAFETY ZONE**

Altering the size of the safety zone from 150 yards to 75 yards from a dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings for archery hunters in Kent County within which archery hunting may not take place except under certain circumstances.
