HB 1467 Delegate Kipke

PUBLIC HEALTH – MENTAL HEALTH ADVANCE DIRECTIVES –
AWARENESS AND STATEWIDE DATABASE

Requiring the Maryland Department of Health to develop and implement a public awareness campaign to encourage the use of mental health advance directives in the State; and requiring the Maryland Behavioral Health Crisis Response System in the Behavioral Health Administration to establish and maintain a centralized statewide database of mental health advance directives.

INCOME TAX SUBTRACTION MODIFICATION – PUBLIC SAFETY
RETIREMENT INCOME

Allowing a subtraction modification under the Maryland income tax for individuals who are at least 55 years old for the first \$15,000 of income from a certain employee retirement system that is attributable to the individual's employment as a public safety employee; and providing that retirement income of public safety employees that is included in the subtraction allowed under the Act may not be taken into account for purposes of a Maryland income tax subtraction modification for certain retirement income.

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HB 1469 Delegate B. Barnes**SCHOOL ARTS FUND – ESTABLISHED**

Establishing the School Arts Fund to provide grants to public schools in Baltimore City to purchase art supplies for classrooms; requiring interest earnings of the Fund to be credited to the Fund; and altering the allocation of revenues from the State Lottery Fund after June 30, 2022.

HB 1470 Delegate Fraser–Hidalgo, et al**STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT – CHESAPEAKE BAY WATERSHED STATES – EXPENSES AND CONTRACTS (QUIT POLLUTING MY BAY ACT OF 2022)**

Requiring the Standard State Travel Regulations adopted under certain provisions of law to prohibit the reimbursement for travel expenses related to travel to a certain state for which the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has identified two or more pollution source sectors at a backstop actions level of oversight; and prohibiting a certain public body from awarding a certain procurement contract for goods or services to a certain business from a certain state under certain circumstances.

Authorizing the County Commissioners of Garrett County and the Board of Governors of the Garrett County Memorial Hospital to lease the hospital or certain portions of the hospital under certain circumstances; and providing for alterations to the Board of Governors under certain circumstances.
