MARYLAND TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION – MARYLAND EQUITY INVESTMENT FUND – ESTABLISHED

Establishing the Maryland Equity Investment Fund in the Maryland Technology Development Corporation; providing for the investment of certain General Fund surplus in certain private equity and venture capital in the State for a certain purpose through the Fund; altering, for fiscal year 2024, the distribution of certain unappropriated General Fund surplus; etc.

CRIMINAL LAW – CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES – SUSPICIOUS ORDER REPORTING
