## HB 1482 Delegate Lierman, et al

STATE RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEM – DIVESTMENT FROM RUSSIA

Requiring the Board of Trustees for the State Retirement and Pension System to review investment holdings in eligible accounts to determine the extent to which these funds are invested in Russia–restricted investments; requiring the Board of Trustees to take certain divestment actions; prohibiting the Board of Trustees from making certain new investments; providing certain immunities from liability for certain persons; requiring the Board of Trustees to act in good faith in taking certain actions in a certain manner; etc. EMERGENCY BILL

VEHICLE LAWS – ELUDING POLICE – PENALTIES

Increasing certain penalties for attempting to elude a police officer; and providing that a person who violates the Act is guilty of a felony and is subject to increasing penalties for multiple offenses.
