# SENATE BILLS INTRODUCED February 22, 2022

### SB 994 Senator Eckardt

PUBLIC HEALTH – MENTAL HEALTH ADVANCE DIRECTIVES – AWARENESS AND STATEWIDE DATABASE

Requiring the Maryland Department of Health to develop and implement a public awareness campaign to encourage the use of mental health advance directives in the State; and requiring the Maryland Behavioral Health Crisis Response System in the Behavioral Health Administration to establish and maintain a centralized statewide database of mental health advance directives.

#### GAMING – ELECTRONIC INSTANT BINGO MACHINES – EXPANSION

Allowing an entity licensed to offer instant bingo under a commercial bingo license on July 1, 2007, to operate up to 300 electronic instant bingo machines more than the number of machines the entity operated on February 28, 2008; and requiring the entity to make a \$1,000 investment in the facility where the machine is located for each additional machine put into operation for the first time after July 1, 2022.

#### STATE PROCUREMENT – SMALL BUSINESS RESERVE PROGRAM

Altering the definition of "small business" for the purposes of the Small Business Reserve Program by adding a requirement that the principal office of the business must be located in the State; increasing from 15% to 30% the minimum percentage of a unit's procurements that, to the extent practicable, are to be made directly from small businesses; and altering the intervals within which certain standards and guidelines for participation in the Small Business Reserve Program are to be established to at least every 5 years.
