## SENATE BILLS INTRODUCED *February 24, 2023*

**SB 955**     **Senator Hettleman, et al**

**ELECTION LAW – 2024 PRIMARY DATE – ALTERATION**

Altering, in 2024, the date of the statewide primary election and the primary election for municipal offices in Baltimore City to the third Tuesday in April.

**CORPORATIONS AND ASSOCIATIONS – COOPERATIVES –  
NONESCHEAT CAPITAL CREDITS**

Providing that certain unclaimed money held by a cooperative and due to a past member is not considered abandoned property; authorizing a cooperative to use this money only to assist members or to donate to charitable organizations; requiring money not expended within 3 years to be considered abandoned property; etc.

**SB 957**     **Senator Benson**

PROPERTY TAX – BUILDING PERMITS – REQUIREMENT TO  
PROVIDE ESTIMATED CONSTRUCTION COSTS TO SUPERVISOR OF  
ASSESSMENTS

Requiring the person responsible for issuing building permits to provide the estimated costs of construction when submitting a copy of a building permit to the supervisor of assessments of the county where the building is located.
