SB 974 **Senator Bailey, et al**

STATE-OWNED NURSING HOMES – DEFICIENCIES, CITATIONS,
AND FINES – CONTRACTOR REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Requiring contractors operating State-owned nursing homes to promptly provide notice of certain deficiencies, enforcement actions, citations, and fines to the Governor, the State agency overseeing the nursing home, certain committees of the General Assembly, and members of the General Assembly who represent the district in which the nursing home is located; etc.
