# SENATE BILLS INTRODUCED February 20, 2024

## SB 1179 Senator Jackson

PROCUREMENT – UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF MARYLAND, MORGAN STATE UNIVERSITY, AND ST. MARY'S COLLEGE OF MARYLAND

Authorizing the Board of Regents of the University System of Maryland to amend certain policies and procedures governing procurements by the University System in a certain manner; and providing that the University System, Morgan State University, and St. Mary's College of Maryland are not required to submit a contract for capital improvements or services for review by the Board of Public Works if the value of the contract is less than \$1,000,000.

#### **SB 1180** Senator Simonaire

CRIMINAL LAW – THREATS AGAINST GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES – EXPANSION

Prohibiting a person from making a threat to take the life of, kidnap, or cause physical injury to an immediate family member of a State or local official or a certain government employee.

# **SB 1181** Senator Jennings

REAL PROPERTY – RECOVERY OF POSSESSION – FILING OF SWORN AFFIDAVIT

Requiring the District Court to issue, and a sheriff to immediately execute, a warrant for possession of a property to a person that has submitted a sworn affidavit stating that a person is unlawfully in possession of the property.

# **SB 1182** Senator Jennings

LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT – NONCOMPETE AND CONFLICT OF INTEREST CLAUSES – VETERINARY AND HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS

Applying to certain veterinary and health care professionals certain provisions of law stating that certain noncompete and conflict of interest provisions in certain employment contracts are null and void as being against the public policy of the State; and applying the Act retroactively.
