SENATE BILL INTRODUCED *February 10, 2026*

SB 959 **Carroll County Senators**

CARROLL COUNTY – ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES – CLASS 1 DISTILLERY ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION PERMIT

Establishing in Carroll County a Class 1 distillery on-premises consumption permit; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Carroll County to issue the permit to a holder of a Class 1 distillery license; and authorizing the holder of a permit to sell food, nonalcoholic beverages, and alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption.

SENATE BILL REASSIGNED February 8, 2026**SB 888 Senators Lam and Ellis****ELECTION DISTRICTS – GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND REPRESENTATIVES IN CONGRESS**

Clarifying that certain requirements apply only to districts for the election of members of the Senate of Maryland and the House of Delegates; authorizing the General Assembly to grant original jurisdiction to the Supreme Court of Maryland to review the congressional districting of the State; and altering districts for the election of Representatives in Congress for elections in 2026 and any election held after the 2026 election through the effective date of a districting plan adopted after the 2030 decennial census.
