SENATE BILLS INTRODUCED August 3, 2026

SB 2100 The President

ELECTION DISTRICTS – GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND
REPRESENTATIVES IN CONGRESS

Clarifying that certain requirements apply only to districts for the election of members of the Senate of Maryland and the House of Delegates; authorizing the General Assembly to grant original jurisdiction to the Supreme Court of Maryland to review the congressional districting plan of the State; and providing that nothing in the Maryland Constitution provides applicable criteria for the boundaries of a congressional districting plan.

ARBITRATION REFORM FOR STATE EMPLOYEES ACT OF 2026 –

Withdrawing and repealing a certain duplicate proposed Constitutional amendment relating to collective bargaining for State employees.

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SB 2102 Senator Hershey, et al

LEGISLATIVE AND CONGRESSIONAL REDISTRICTING AND
LEGISLATIVE AND CONGRESSIONAL REDISTRICTING AND
APPORTIONMENT COMMISSION (FAIR DISTRICTS FOR MARYLAND
ACT)

Requiring single-member delegate districts; altering certain standards for the drawing of legislative districts; establishing standards for the drawing of congressional districts; establishing the Legislative and Congressional Redistricting and Apportionment Commission as an independent unit of State government to divide the State into certain legislative districts and congressional districts subject to certain requirements and procedures; etc.

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT – CONTINGENT

Maryland Constitution, Various Articles, Various Sections - amended,
repealed, and added and EL, §§ 8-7A-01 through 8-7A-11 - added
