To whom it may concern,

I want to thank you and your Committee for presenting HB 0115 for consideration today. After consulting with Delegate Davis's Office in November 2019, I was informed by the Maryland State Retirement Office that I had selected Plan 1 of the Maryland Teachers' Pension Options.

At the time of my retirement I could not have foreseen that the cost of living would have increased as it did, nor could I have imagined that there would have been significant changes in my personal well being and that of my family. Consequently, I did not request a larger monthly pension.

REASONS FOR INCREASED PENSION:

- 1. My husband passed away from cancer in late 2011. The blow has severely damaged the psyche of myself and all 3 of my sons who are still coping with issues in relation to the loss.
- 2. The reduction to a single household income and struggle to refinance was financially crippling during an unprecedented national mortgage crisis that my household is still recovering from.
- 3. My youngest son returned home from the military with health issues which prevented him from being employed for nearly 2 years within which I have had to cover his expenses.
- 4. My second son overworked himself trying to contribute and stressed with concern over my health and that of his younger brother is only now recovering from mental health challenges.
- 5. During my 29 years of service to the Prince George's County Public school system as a Spanish Teacher and National Honor Society organizer, I developed respiratory and other chronic health issues which have caused me to revolutionize my diet out of necessity.
- 6. For the past 2 years I have not been able to afford new glasses.

I pray these concerns are consequential enough to motivate this committee to act.
