Collaborations for the Laundry Truck

Women of Positive Change would manage the mobile laundry truck and collaborate with agencies in Montgomery County, Prince Georges County and Baltimore County to provide homeless people access to clean water to wash clothes. The following organizations have agreed to participate in this endeavor to support Women of Positive Change in creating a coalition for the Mobile Laundry Initiative.

- Wells Robertson House has agreed to collaborate with Women of Positive Change to promote outreach to the vulnerable community that is unseen. In addition, Wells Robertson has agreed to consult with Women of Positive Change to help with the program when needed.
- 2. Tree of Hope is a peer- driven organization that has pledge to be a part of the coalition by creating dialog and resources to the community that lives unsheltered and needs access to clean water.
- 3. Global Generosity has agreed to consult with Women of Positive Change to help bring access to clean water through laundry services and/or showers.
- 4. On Our Own of Baltimore has agreed to collaborate and provide outreach to the vulnerable population in need of access to the mobile laundry truck. On Our Own recognizes a need for the mobile truck in their area and has agreed to work with Women of Positive Change to bring the services to the area through outreach and communication through their Wellness Center.
- 5. One Voice Dundalk has agreed to support Women of Positive Change with the Mobile Laundry truck for the Homeless for a variety of reasons, such as, no access to water, no income, no transportation, no friend or family support, and minimal clothing,
- 6. Montgomery County Federation of Families has agreed to join this coalition and provide support to Women of Positive Change in regards to the Mobile Laundry.
