HB 102 - Public Service Commission - Public Utility Regulation Fund - Cap

The Public Service Commission's (PSC) operating budget is funded through special funds by annually assessing all public service companies a percentage of their reported intrastate operating revenues. The cost and expenses of the PSC and the Office of People's Counsel are borne by the public service companies subject to the PSC's jurisdiction.

According to research conducted by the PSC, Maryland is 1 of 28 states with a cap on revenues that public utility commissions can collect through assessment. Of those states, 21 have a higher cap than Maryland. The PSC reports the General Assembly last increased this statutory cap in 1977.

HB 102 increases the maximum assessment from 0.17 % to 0.25%. I request a favorable report on this legislation.
