**Senate Bill 141**  
**Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - Salaries of Inspectors**

Chairman Pinsky, Vice Chair Kagan and Members of Education, Health and Environmental Affairs:

Thank you for allowing me the opportunity to introduce **SB 141 Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - Salaries of Inspectors**. This is a simple bill giving a minor raise to inspectors employed by the Board of License Commissioners. Inspectors in Anne Arundel County have not had a pay increase in years. This bill will increase the part-time Chief Inspector from \$10,000 to \$11,000, the part-time Deputy Chief Inspector, from \$8,000 to \$9,000, and the other part-time inspectors from \$6,000 to \$7,000 annually. The work load of the inspectors is expected to significantly increase due to the availability of licenses for Florists, Theaters, salons and barbershops. This small raise will aid in retaining qualified and dedicated inspectors to continue this important work in Anne Arundel County.

The cost will be funded from the Liquor Board's revenue and ensure they continue to provide quality service to their clients. It will not be borne by the taxpayers.

This bill has the support of the Anne Arundel County Senate Delegation and the Anne Arundel Board of License Commissioners.

I respectfully request the Committee give SB 141 a favorable report.
