Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - Board of License Commissioners Staff and Compensation

Chairman Pinsky, Vice Chair Kagan and Members of Education, Health and Environmental Affairs:

Thank you for the opportunity to introduce **SB 221 Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - Board of License Commissioners Staff and Compensation**. This legislation, if enacted, will increase the staff of the Anne Arundel County Liquor Board from 3 to 4, adding one new secretarial position. SB 221 also permits the Board to elevate one of the current Administrators to a full-time Executive Director. The resulting staff will include an Executive Director, pay grade 17; one full-time administrator, pay grade 16; and two full-time secretaries, pay grade 13. The cost of this change will be funded from the Liquor Board revenue and ensure they continue to provide quality service to their clients. The board believes these changes are overdue and is appropriate given the increasing workload of the Liquor Board.

This bill has the support of the Anne Arundel County Senate Delegation and the Anne Arundel Board of License Commissioners.

I respectfully request a favorable report on SB 221.
