**SENATE BILL 239 Anne Arundel County – Alcoholic Beverages –
Small Yacht Club License**

DATE: February 28, 2020

COMMITTEE: Education, Health and Environmental Affairs

SUMMARY OF BILL: Establishes the Class C (Small Yacht Club License) in Anne Arundel County

EXPLANATION:

Established for small yacht clubs meeting the following criteria:

1. Minimum of 30 members, each paying a minimum membership fee of \$75 per year
2. A clubhouse used principally by members and their guests
3. Slips, boat parking spaces or berths for at least 25 boats

Yacht Club Member/Applicant for the Small Yacht Club license, must be a resident, registered voter and taxpayer of Anne Arundel County.

For the sale of beer, wine and liquor for on-premises consumption.
