**Senate Bill 360**  
**Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class MT (Movie Theater) License**

Chairman Pinsky, Vice Chair Kagan and Members of Education, Health and Environmental Affairs;

Thank you for the opportunity to introduce **Senate Bill 360 - Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class MT (Movie Theater) License**. This Bill creates a new beer, wine and liquor license, Class MT. This new license will allow movie theaters to sell alcoholic beverages in Anne Arundel County. SB 360 stipulates the MT license will only allow movie theaters to serve alcohol in single serve containers for on-premises consumption by patrons having purchased a ticket for a movie during normal hours of business, no later than midnight. It also requires movie theaters to serve alcohol from a separate counter from where normal movie theater concessions are sold. The license will cost \$1,200 and the license holder will not need to obtain a separate Sunday license.


