CAI represents individuals and professionals who reside in or work with condominiums, homeowners' associations and cooperatives throughout the State of Maryland.

MD-LAC opposes HB 218. Please note that HB 1053- Real Property – Condominiums and Homeowners Associations – Governing Bodies addresses the issues contained in HB 218. As such, in our testimony on HB 1053, we shall propose an
