The Maryland Occupational Therapy Association (MOTA) supports House Bill 364 – Hospital and Nursing Facility Workers and Health Care Practitioners – Identification Tags and Badges – Name Requirement. The bill makes a technical correction to existing law. Health care practitioners would have the option of displaying a first or last name, rather than their full name, on their name badges.

This legislation proposes a small clarification of the law, but it has tremendous importance to health care practitioners. Unfortunately, health care settings have become more dangerous. The Joint Commission has released a sentinel event alert to focus attention on the issue. This bill would allow health care providers the option of displaying only part of their name on a badge when they have safety concerns.
