Subject: Support for House Bill-1495 (HB-1495) (Constitutional Amendment)

I recognize that the ramifications of the recent decision from the Supreme Court of the . United States (Court) in the Rucho et al. v. Common Cause et al. and Lamone et al. v. Benisek et al. cases addressing partisan, political congressional districts gerrymandering, can apply to the process for restructuring legislative districts in Maryland.

I believe that HB-1495 sets forth a reasonable and realistic method to address any necessary restructuring of Maryland's legislative districts subsequent to the 2020 census. This method parallels that proposed in HB-1460 for restructuring congressional districts and provides succinct and fair criteria to be applied to all legislative districts whose construction falls under the purview of Maryland's Constitution.

I fully support this amendment proposal, HB- 1495, and urge this Committee to render a favorable report. In addition, I also urge all House of Delegates members to vote for HB-1495 and send it to the Maryland voters for the November 2020 election.
