Re: Letter of Support – Senate Bill 29 – Criminal Law – Life Threatening Injury Involving a Motor Vehicle or Vessel – Criminal Negligence (Wade’s Law)

Dear Chair Smith and Committee Members:

The Maryland Department of Natural Resources supports Senate Bill 29 because it provides a mechanism by which to hold persons accountable for criminally negligent behavior, when not under the influence of drugs or alcohol, and when that behavior results in life-threatening injury to another.

The standard of proof required by this legislation would be below the level of gross negligence, which is often difficult to prove. This bill also does not require proof that the operator was impaired while engaged in the criminally negligent behavior, which is currently required by CR § 3-211. This legislation would provide a valuable enforcement tool to address unsafe behavior.

For this reason, the Maryland Department of Natural Resources respectfully requests the Committee to grant Senate Bill 29 a favorable report.
